He has just written Think Like a Nurse, a three-volume student textbook set that provides a practice-based perspective on essential content including the development of clinical judgment.

Driven by a passion for empowering, inspiring, and educating the next generation of nurses, Keith launched KeithRN in 2012 to pursue his vision of transforming nursing education using active learning and educational best practices to improve practice readiness by developing clinical judgment essential for safe practice.
